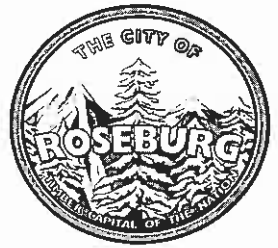

ISSUE STATEMENT AND SUMMARY

This joint meeting with the City Council, Public Works, Parks & Recreation, and Planning Commission is an opportunity for a thorough review of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan components that have been prepared up to this point. The plan is nearing completion and this review will give all involved a chance to understand the plan and its intent. This workshop allows for questions or concerns to be expressed prior to the final draft being completed to help ensure that adoption and implementation proceed smoothly.

BACKGROUND

- A. Council Action History.** In February of 2008, Council authorized submittal of a grant application to the State Transportation & Growth Management Program for the preparation of an updated Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan. Council had an update at their March 9 meeting.
- B. Analysis.** The project has proceeded under the review of a project management team and a review committee, working with Shelley Oylear of Parametrix, the consulting firm for the plan who will be making today's presentation. The project management team had representatives from the Community Development Department, Public Works Department, Police Department, and Parks Division, as well as representatives from Douglas County, Umpqua Transit, Roseburg School District, and ODOT. The twelve member review committee had representatives from the Planning Commission, Public Works Commission, and Parks & Recreation Commission/City Council, as well as community stakeholders.

There have been many and various activities with participants from Council, Commissions, staff and the public. This joint meeting is the Spring workshop noted at the March 9 update; again the intent is to ensure that any issues which may arise do so before the plan is completed.

The completed plan will come before Council as an amendment to the Transportation System Plan (TSP), which is a part of the Comprehensive Plan; and amendments to

the Land Use and Development Ordinance. In addition, there are other activities identified that will need implementation.

- C. **Financial and/or Resource Considerations.** This project is grant funded; City participation is in the form of a 12% match of \$9600 met by in-kind staff participation.
- D. **Timing Issues.** The grant agreement for this project terminates June 30, 2009. The project is proceeding well and should be completed on time.
- E. **Staff Recommendation.** No formal action is required; however, staff is asking for direction.
